The Clearbrook-Gonvick 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant summer program is a FREE program for all students going into 5th - 12th grade. This fun program will consist of many exciting hands on science activities with a focus on character building sessions to help students gain self-confidence, build qualities like initiative, leadership, and a positive attitude. The projects and activities will be taught by certified teachers. A description of each activity are highlighted below. ## Zoo Snooze!

Each student who participates in the summer program and meets the designated program criteria will qualify to go on a FREE overnight field trip to the Lake Superior Zoo in Duluth!

Yes, we will be spending the night at the zoo! During our stay we will take a night hike around the zoo, have live animal encounters, enjoy a pizza party, get a free t-shirt and a continental breakfast the next morning.



## Summer Skills Sharpener

To keep student's academic skills sharp, a Summer Skills book in Math and Language Arts will be purchased for each student. These books review skills for the grade level they just completed and help prevent "summer learning loss". Maintaining these academic skills will ensure students will be prepared when starting school again in the fall.

## "Hands On" Projects



**Owl Pellets** - Students will learn about food webs by dissecting an owl pellet. Owl pellets are regurgitated owl prey (don't worry, the pellets are sterilized). Each student will get to dissect a pellet and use bone sorting charts to identify the owls prey.

**Geology** - Students will learn about the three types of rocks, Igneous, Sedimentary and Metamorphic, how they are formed and how to identify them.

**Fingerprinting** - Learn how forensic scientists identify missing or wanted people by using their fingerprints. We will identify the different types of fingerprints and find out what type you have!

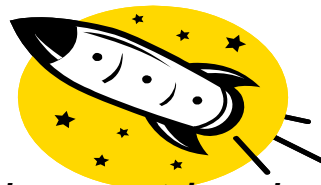


**Fossils** - As an expansion of geology, students will study fossils, how they are formed and what we can learn from them. Each student will get a chance to make their own fossil.



## Rocketry

**Rockets are a great way to learn about science, technology and math together in one project! First students will learn the basics of rocketry and then put together a modified protractor to help them determine the height of a rockets flight. Then we will head outside to launch some rockets and do simple calculations with our protractors to find out just how high each rocket actually flew.**



## Hovercraft

**What can you do with a vacuum besides clean the house? Use some plywood, a few bolts, and an old shower curtain and make a hovercraft! A homemade hovercraft can lift several people. We will cover the why's and how's of this fun to make project, then students will help put a hovercraft together and drive them around in the school gym.**



**The C-G School has purchased a license for Study Island, a web-based program that helps kids practice topics too prepare them for the state standardized tests that all students are required to take.**



## Movies

The PG movies we will be viewing are based on themes that reinforce positive behaviors and inspire imagination. The teachers will be using Professional curriculums that have been developed specifically for each of the movies that include excellent interactive activity guides. The positive behaviors we will be reinforcing are: Reaching out to new friends and neighbors, anti-bullying, what you can learn from a good friendship, inspire your imagination and Creativity, communicating to mend and build relationships. A permission slip will be sent home for parents to approve the viewing of each of the movies. Parents are free to borrow the movies to watch themselves upon request.



## Participation Criteria

**Programming is scheduled 4 hours per day 4 days a week. Students will be required to attend a minimum of 8 hours per week. The minimum hours are designed to ensure students will put enough hours in each week to benefit from the program but flexible enough to not hinder them from their involvement in other summer activities. A student must meet the 8 hours of programming in order to qualify for the Duluth Zoo incentive trip. If vacations or summer camps prevent the student from meeting the requirement of 8 hours that week, it can be made up the next week.**
