A FREE Sack Lunch with milk, juice and snacks will be sent with each child under 18. All adults can buy the sack lunch for \$3.00. (indicate this on registration)

Dress in appropriate clothing for the weather that day and for hiking outdoors.

Participants will be split into small groups and dropped off at different geocache sites. A designated amount of time will be given to find the cache. When the time is up the groups will be picked up and brought to a different site. **The number of caches we will try to locate depends on how many people register.**
