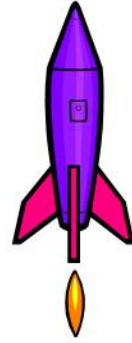

Minimum Requirements

Register and create your account

1. Go to the Honeywell Instant Alert for Schools website listed above.
2. If you are not a staff member in the school, click on 'Parent' in the New User box.
3. If you are a staff member in the school, use the user name and password given to you by the school.
4. Complete the student information form. Click 'Submit.'
5. Complete the corresponding screen. Click 'Submit.'
6. After receiving the Confirmation message, click 'Proceed' to get started with Instant Alert.
7. Note: Remember your Login Name and Password so you may use it to update your profile.

View and check details about yourself and your family members

1. Upon successful login, click on 'My Family.'
2. Click on a parent name to view and edit parent details.
3. Click on a student name to view details about your children enrolled in this school.

Configure alert settings for yourself

1. Click on 'Alert Setup.'
 2. Click on the check boxes to select which alert type you would like to have sent to which device. Click on 'Save' when complete.
 3. If you would like to add another contact device, select the device type and enter the device details. Select the person to whom the device belongs and click on 'Add.'
 4. For e-mail, text messaging and pagers you may send yourself a test message. Click on 'Send Test Message' to send yourself a message.

Click on 'Alert History' to view Alerts that have been sent to you. Use calendar icons and 'Alert Type' list to filter Alerts.

Identify key contacts for your children

1. Click on 'Other Contacts.'
 2. Click on 'Add New Contact' and complete the form.
 3. Click on the 'Pick Up Rights' check box if you wish to allow this person the right to pick up your child from school. This person's name will appear on a report for the school.
 4. Click on 'Save' when complete.
 5. If you would like this person to receive Alerts from the school, return to the 'Alert Setup' page to configure this person's alert settings.

Make note of **PREREGISTRATION DATES**. **You must register and pay to participate in any activity**. Late registration will be accepted on a space available basis.

WE ENCOURAGE YOU TO REGISTER during the following times: **Friday, June 4, Monday & Tuesday, June 7 & 8 from 10:00-6:00 in the school Commons**. **Use a separate form for each child**.

Extra forms are available during registration. If you are not registering for baseball or softball you may send registrations to: CG Summer Rec., 16770 Clearwater Lake Road, Clearbrook, MN 56634. Those registering for baseball/softball should pay their uniform deposit and/or purchase or pick up their uniforms. See more information on the registration form. To register after the above times, please contact Judy.

Refunds will be given for canceled activities. If you will be unable to attend an activity you have registered for, please call as soon as possible. Refunds will not be given if students do not show up for an activity without contacting us or are removed from an activity because of poor behavior. All refunds will be made at the conclusion of Summer Recreation.

Hang on to your brochure! If you wish to add an activity at a later date, contact the Community Ed office regarding space. Please be aware that registrations are on a first paid/first served basis.

Notice-If you need transportation to activities one option is to contact Heartland Express at 1-800-245-6064. Many participants make use of this service on a regular basis. A **NEW option this year is THE BUS**. Regular bus routes are available between Clearbrook, Gonvick, Leonard, Shevlin and Bagley for a fee. SUMMER FEST THEATER: (ages 7-adult) (cost-\$10.00)

***PLEASE NOTE- THE PLAY WILL BE HELD JULY 19-24, NOT DURING SUMMERFEST WEEK AS IN THE PAST.**

Auditions for Prairie Fire Children's Theaters original musical production of "A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM" will be held on **Monday, July 19**, from **2:30-4:30** in the school commons. About 40-60 young people and adults from Clearbrook-Gonvick and surrounding communities are needed to play the roles of Buck, Luck, Yuck-Yuck, and the rest of the Groundlings; Titania, Oberon, Pease Blossom, Cobweb, Moth, Mustardseed, and the rest of the Sprites; Quince, Flute, Starveling, Snout, Snug, and the Understudies of the acting troupe, The Duke, Hermia, Lysander, Demetrius, Helena, and the rest of the Noblemen and Noblewomen. Assistant Directors and technical people (sound and lights) are needed as well. Two professional actors/directors Rachel Kuhnle and Mathew Dreier will direct the production and play the roles of the mischievous sprite, Puck and the colorful, Nick Bottom.



Auditions are open to ages **7-adult**. The **audition session** will last **2 hours** and all auditioners are needed for the full two hours. The cast will be announced at the end of the session (some cast members may practice for a short time after auditions). No preparation is necessary. **Rehearsals** will be held from **2:30-6:45 each day** the remainder of the week. Auditioners should clear their schedules. **Show times** are Friday and Saturday, July 23 & 24 at 7:00 pm in the school commons. Ticket prices are: Adults-\$5.00, Students-\$3.00, Preschool-\$1.00. This Prairie Fire residency is sponsored by the Clearbrook-Gonvick 21st Century program and Clearbrook-Gonvick Community Ed.

GEOCACHING: JUNE 28, 29, JULY 6 (grades: going into 3-6)(cost-\$6.00/ class or \$15.00)— Learn how to use a GPS to find hidden “treasure”. Students will participate in various treasure hunts around the school, learning how to mark a location where they hide something, so that other students can find it using their GPS. We will also hide things for the students to find. You will be able to either eat what you find or take it home with you. **YOU MUST ATTEND AT LEAST 1 GEOCACHING CLASS IN ORDER TO GO ON THE GEOCACHING TRIP TO ITASCA.** Meet from 3:00-4:30 in the Art room. ROCKETS: JULY 15 (grades: going into 2-4)(cost-\$5.00)— Students will be able to join in the fun of shooting water powered rockets. Students will take a plastic pop bottle, and change it into a rocket, then stand back and watch the fun as they shoot them off, and chase them down – and do it all over again! Wear tennis shoes! Meet from 3:00-4:30 in the Art Room. Instructor is Chris Bakke.

ATHLETICS, PHYSICAL FITNESS



SOCCER: JUNE 14-17 (ages 7-13)(cost-\$7.00)--Learn basic soccer skills and strategy. Meet at Kloster Park from 3:30-5:00. Nick Rankin will instruct. **PREREGISTER and PAY by JUNE 10.**

FLAG FOOTBALL: JULY 12-15 (ages 7-13)(cost-\$7.00)--Have fun with flag football! Meet at Kloster Park from 3:30-5:00. **PREREGISTER and PAY by JULY 8.**



BASKETBALL CAMP: JULY 27 (Boys & Girls going into grades 1-3 (cost-FREE)(3:00-6:00 PM)

Join us at the Clearbrook-Gonvick High School Gym for an afternoon packed full of drills, games, and challenges that will improve your basketball skills. You will be instructed by our High School Basketball Players. Your families are invited to join us at 5:40 for an award ceremony. Hope to see you there! Ross Faldet--coordinator. **PREREGISTRATION ENCOURAGED BUT NOT REQUIRED.** You may use the Summer Recreation registration form or Contact Mr. Faldet at 776-3324.

SOFTBALL/BASEBALL: (age as of June 1)-Basic skills are taught at each level. As players get older, more team strategies are taught. Games and/or tournaments are scheduled for each group. ***NOTE--Any requests for players moving up an age group should be directed to the coaches. Coaches will evaluate the players for 1-2 weeks and then decide if they are ready both physically and socially to move up. All softball & baseball practices are at Kloster Park in Clearbrook. Cadet League schedule available about June 15.*

TEAM PHOTOS: We will have a PHOTO DAY for each team. You may bring your own cameras and take photos. We will also take team photos and post them on our web site so you can download and print as you wish. NO professional photos will be taken. More info when you register for baseball and softball.

T-BALL: (boys and girls ages 5-6)--soft safety ball is used--tournaments on Mondays (one Sunday)

MITES: (boys ages 7-8)--soft baseball is used--tournaments on Mondays (one Sunday)

MIDGETS: (girls ages 7-8)--soft softball is used--tournaments on Mondays (one Sunday)

BANTAMS: (girls ages 9-11*)--regulation softball--tournaments--Thursdays--modified fast pitch

*11 year olds may choose either Bantams or Ponies

PONIES: (girls ages *11-13)--regulation softball--tournaments--Thursdays--fast pitch

PEEWEEES: (boys ages 9-10)--regulation baseball used--tournaments on Tuesdays

CADETS: (boys ages 11-13)--regulation baseball used--tournaments/league on Thursdays



KLOSTER PARK BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL LEAGUES: (cost-\$12.00)(boys & girls ages 9-14). This is a pitching machine league which is played every Wednesday, June 16-July 21 from 9:00-2:30. Participants are from Bagley, Clearbrook-Gonvick, Fosston, Oklee, Plummer, Red Lake and Win-E-Mac. Players will be drafted on teams and play a 5 week regular season. There will be 9-11 boys and girls leagues and 12-14 boys and girls leagues. The World Series will be played on Sunday, July 25. This is a great way to make new friends.

TRIPS !!!

SEVEN CLANS WATER PARK—JULY 16 (cost-\$20.00) (ages 9-& up)—Enjoy a wet & wild time at the indoor water park near Thief River Falls. The facility includes 4 large slides, 3 starter slides, a lazy river with rapids and waterfalls, two giant jacuzzis, video arcade center and more. Several snack shops are available. Bring money for food and arcades as desired. This is a shared trip with Bagley. Leave Clearbrook at 9:45 am. Return about 3:15 pm. **PREREGISTER & PAY by JULY 12.**

GEOCACHING--JULY 8 (cost \$10.00) (next years 3rd grade & up)—(3rd grade must have an adult with them) Kids if you have already been geocaching, you know how much fun this is – if you haven't been geocaching yet, this is a great time to try it! Geocaching is a “world-wide” hide-and-go-seek / outdoor activity that is fun for all ages! The basic idea is to locate a hidden container, called a geocache using hand held GPS devices. We will be hunting for caches at Itasca State Park. A separate form/permission slip with detailed information and an itinerary will be given to each student when they register for the field trip. **SACK LUNCH PROVIDED (including chaperones).**

Parents/Guardians, we will need chaperones (NO FEE) so please let us know if you are interested in going along. We'll leave school at **8:45 a.m.** and geocache all day, returning around **4:30 p.m.** **YOU MUST ATTEND AT LEAST 1 GEOCACHING CLASS (SEE PREVIOUS PAGE) TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS TRIP.** This trip is in collaboration with the 21st Century Community Learning Centers grant program. **PREREGISTER by JULY 1.**
